2. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This document, represents an addendum to the CPS ICERT-INDI-MO and ICERT-INDI-IPSPS of the Certification Authority Tinexta Infocert S.p.A.; it aims to provide a list of Italian and foreign identity documents and electronic identification processes which, based on the compliance assessments performed, have been deemed acceptable for the purpose of the proper identification of the Subject within the context of the issuance processes for qualified electronic signature certificates. The personnel responsible for the identification process have received specific training.

3. ACCEPTED DOCUMENTS

The identity documents, as listed in the table below, may be accepted in relation to all identification methods as defined in par. 3.2.3 Authentication of the natural person of the CPS (ICERT-INDI-MO) and in par. 1.2 of the Operational Manual of the Identity Verification Service (ICERT-INDI-IPSPS).

Please note that only machine readable digital identity documents (eMRT) compliant with ICAO 9303 are accepted. Based on the reference list provided below and, on this requirement, it is also possible to configure the system to accept only a subset of the listed documents.

In line with the requirement relating to the acceptance of passports, national identity cards and other official documents offering a comparable or higher level of reliability, assessed on the basis of security features and the issuance process, Tinexta Infocert may, in specific identification contexts, also accept additional types of documentation not expressly referred to in this document. Such possibility may apply, for example, in closed-domain contexts or for the issuance of certificates intended for controlled ecosystems, provided that the assessment required by the requirement has been carried out and that equivalent reliability with respect to the reference documents has been demonstrated. In such cases, the Holders shall be duly informed of the documents admitted within the relevant context.

Where Swiss law applies, the following documents are accepted for identification purposes: the Swiss identity card, identity cards issued by countries belonging to the Schengen Area, and passports compliant with the ICAO standard.
